WHAT IT IS

A network that lives in its people's computers.



Take part with an everyday CPU

Brisvia uses RandomX so mining can be done with ordinary processors, without depending on specialized mining hardware.



Transparent and verifiable

Transactions, issuance and consensus rules can be audited publicly in the open-source code and on the network.



No owner with an edge

There is no premine or private sale. From block 1, the same published rules apply to the creator and every other participant.

It is not just about having a coin. The core experience is simpler: **my computer takes part**, the rules are the same for everyone, and the network does not depend on one person or one central server.

THE THREE PROMISES**FUNCTIONAL**

"Install Brisvia and help sustain an open monetary network from your own computer."

EMOTIONAL

"You are not watching someone else's network. You are part of the network."

MORAL

"No premine. No private sale. No special permissions. The same rules from the first block."

THE SOUL OF THE PROJECT

A fair launch isn't promised afterward. It's designed from the start.

From block 1, everyone participates with the same public software, information and consensus rules.

Code, issuance, validation and network activity are visible and independently verifiable.

The special edge does not exist.

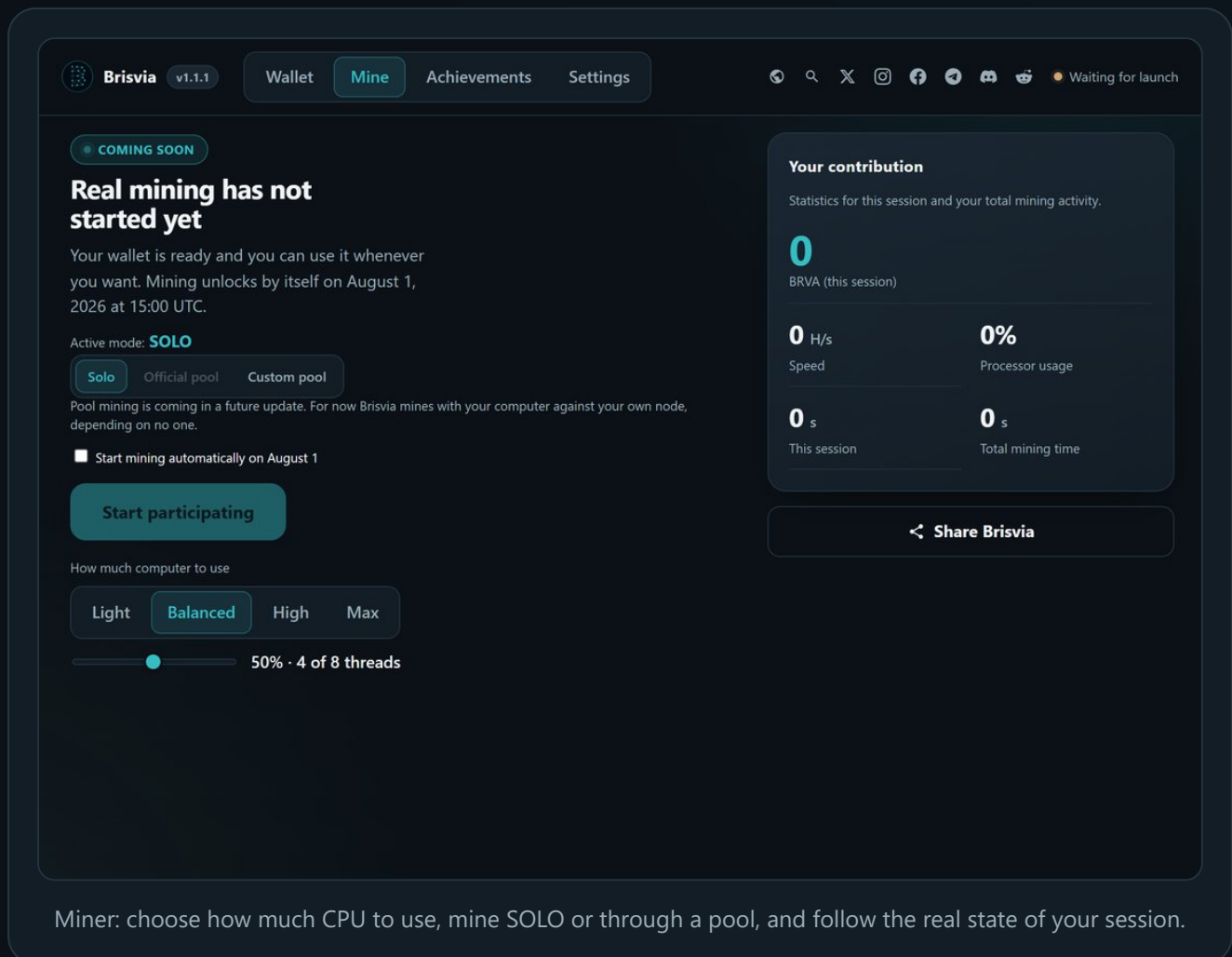

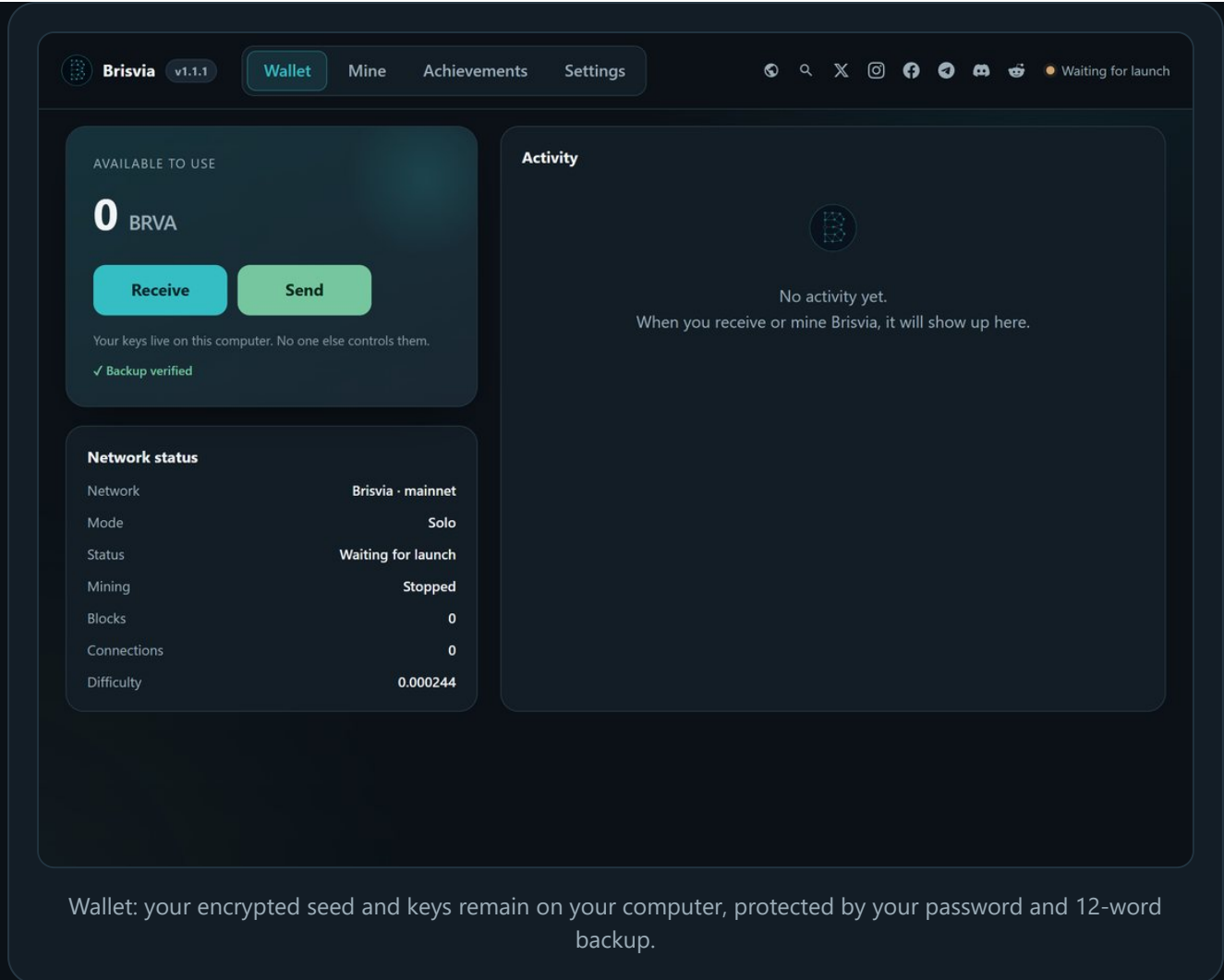
Knowing who started Brisvia does not weaken decentralization. Trust comes from something more concrete: the founder receives no technical, economic or access privilege.

— THE APP

One app, and you're in.

Brisvia Desktop brings the wallet, node and miner together in one application. It is built for Windows, macOS Apple Silicon and Linux, with signed in-app update verification.





- The mining button unlocks when mainnet opens; mining does not start automatically by default.
- The same 12-word seed can restore the corresponding wallet in compatible Brisvia applications.
- An independent console miner is also available for advanced users and Linux servers.

macOS release note: the first public build is distributed without Apple Developer ID notarization and may require manual approval in Privacy & Security.

Bitcoin Core v30.2 provides a proven UTXO model and an auditable base for transaction, block and network validation.

RandomX v1.2.2 CPU mining, ASERT difficulty adjustment, finite issuance rules and block validation are integrated and tested.

Getting nodes to talk

A shared test network now synchronizes several nodes, validates the same chain and recovers from interruptions and reorganizations.

Why there is a date and not a countdown: public opening has a fixed time, but release readiness is still decided by evidence. Mainnet opens on August 1, 2026 at 15:00 UTC only after the required validation gates are complete.

PRODUCT PRINCIPLE

Complexity stays inside.

A person should be able to install, protect a wallet, choose a CPU limit and participate without becoming a protocol expert.

The roadmap describes current work and development goals. It is not an investment offer or a promise of price, performance, profit, adoption, liquidity or third-party listing.

SECURITY PRINCIPLE

Every shortcut is paid later.

That is why public opening follows testing, reproducible evidence and clear tools to verify what is happening.

THE COIN

Finite, predictable issuance, with no shortcuts.

Each mined block follows public consensus rules. The reward halves at fixed block intervals until no further subsidy can be created. No one receives spendable coins in advance.

Issuance is finite and public: the rules are in the open-source software and can be checked independently. Scarcity does not promise value; it only makes the monetary rules explicit and prevents a permanent tail emission.

Technical base: Bitcoin Core v30.2 · RandomX v1.2.2 · ASERT · 80-byte block header · SHA-256d block identifier · RandomX proof of work.

— HOW TO START

Joining takes three steps.

1 Download the official software

Get Brisvia Desktop for Windows, macOS Apple Silicon or Linux from brisvia.com or the official GitHub release. Advanced users can also use the console miner.

2 Save your 12 words

Write the recovery words down and store them safely. Anyone with those words controls the wallet; Brisvia cannot recover them for you.

3 Choose how to participate

When mainnet opens, mine SOLO or connect to the official 0% fee pool. Select the CPU intensity that fits your computer and electricity use.
